SCOTT FLAVIN, VIOLIN/VIOLA

Scott Flavin enjoys an incredibly versatile musical career. Since 1998 he has been a professor of violin at the Frost School of Music of the University of Miami, where he is a member of the internationally-acclaimed Bergonzi String Quartet, as well as Artistic Coordinator and Resident Conductor for UM's Henry Mancini Institute Orchestra. He also is concertmaster of Florida Grand Opera and the Miami Bach Society, and appears in concert across the country and around the world. As a composer and arranger, his works have been heard on American Public Media's program "Performance Today" and have been recorded by the Bergonzi Quartet. As a conductor, he has performed at various music festivals, broadcast television, and has appeared on the podium with such diverse artists as Denyce Graves, Chick Corea, Bobby McFerrin, and Mark O'Connor, and is Music Director of the Miami Mozarteum Orchestra. His recordings include chamber music on the Naxos, M&W, and Centaur labels, and commercial recordings on Sony, EMI, and Warner Brothers, including appearances on over a dozen Grammy Awardwinning albums. He has recorded two solo CDs, "Great Violin Solos of the Opera and Ballet" and "The Complete Brahms Violin Sonatas".
